Hope in the darkness of war

Since the start of the conflict in Ukraine in February 2022, more than 13 million people have been forced to leave their homes behind. As the war in Ukraine enters its third year, Habitat remains committed to helping affected families secure durable solutions to their housing needs.

Pray for those who have been forced to flee the violence and those who are displaced in Ukraine itself. Pray for the Habitat staff in Ukraine and surrounding countries who are supporting refugees from Ukraine and the communities left behind.

Give thanks for additional funds from the Church of Ireland's 'Bishop's Appeal' which will support the delivery of further vital stoves for families in the Kharkiv region of Ukraine. Pray for those affected by war, famine and disaster around the world and for all those who reach out to help.

Pray for many customers who find hope through ReStore, where they are able to access low-cost materials to improve their homes.
